PEGASUS RESIDENTS' GROUP INCORPORATED (PRGI)

A brief history

The Pegasus Residents' Group was formed in mid-2011 and became an incorporated society in September 2013. The main driving force behind the original committee was setting up a volunteer Community Watch team.

The current PRG Committee is made up of residents with a diverse range of ages, interests and backgrounds. This dedicated team of volunteers collectively provide hundreds of hours for the Pegasus Community each year. PRGI is bound by its constitution and the Incorporated Societies Act 1908.



The purpose of Pegasus Residents' Group Incorporated:

- *To promote, preserve and protect the interests of the residents of Pegasus Residents' Group Incorporated's area.*
- *To support the efforts of any person, persons, association, or any other bodies who may, in the opinion of PRGI, be working for the benefit of the Pegasus area.*
- *To foster social activities within PRGI's area.*

Here are some of the things that PRGI have achieved and continue to be involved in

- Coordinate Pegasus volunteer Community Watch team (13 years) and run the community watch vehicle and are responsible for all costs related to its upkeep and running
- Established a PRGI Lake Subcommittee and advocate for improved water quality and elimination of algal bloom with stakeholders (Templeton Group, WDC, ECan, Golder)
- PRGI have been invited and sent representatives to attend meetings including the Northern Pegasus Bay Bylaw Advisory Group, Civil Defence meeting, District Development Strategy, NZTA Safe Roads Alliance and more
- Developed a residents' map of Pegasus and Woodend-Ravenswood
- Ongoing contact with outside organisations as required, including Social Services Waimakariri, Te Kōhaka o Tūhaitara Trust, NZ Police, Civil Defence, Waka Kotahi (NZTA), ECan, Woodend/Pegasus Menz Shed, local businesses and many more
- Liaised with WDC and Templeton Group (current Pegasus development owners) on various maintenance and other issues of concern to residents
- Organised public meetings with developers, WDC, Civil Defence, Te Kōhaka o Tūhaitara Trust, NZTA, NZ Police and more.
- Worked with WDC to secure a community centre for Pegasus (opened May 2017 and expanded September 2019)
- Work with WDC staff to help facilitate the Pegasus Community Centre
- Regular liaison with Woodend Community Association and Woodend-Sefton Community Board

- Naming of “Bob’s Bridge” suspension bridge
- Liaised with WDC to have accessways for pedestrians and cyclists created between Pegasus Main St and Gladstone Rd; from Infinity Dr to Gladstone Park; and from Kaiapoi Pa Rd to Tiritiri Moana Dr
- Facilitated the installation of a defibrillator which is available to the community 24/7 and is located outside the Pegasus Medical Centre (52 Pegasus Main Street, Pegasus)
- Liaised with WDC to have an emergency exit gate installed from Pegasus Main St to Gladstone Rd (2017) and to have that accessway upgraded in 2019
- Regular updates and information in *The Woodpecker* magazine
- Organised free community Christmas on the Lake event (9 years)
- Organised and paid for sign and garden on Pegasus Boulevard (by golf course)
- Successfully advocated for improvements to the maintenance of the Pegasus entrance outside the golf club on Pegasus Boulevard
- Advocate for improvements to State Highway 1 from Ashley River to Belfast, including the Woodend Bypass
- Organise volunteers to staff the community centre enabling the public access to free books, jigsaws, and information about Pegasus.
- Send PRGI members minutes from the PRGI monthly committee meetings
- Send PRGI members monthly newsletters and exclusive updates
- Developing an Emergency Community Hub at Pegasus Community Centre (with Civil Defence)
